- Grades 4-9 with initial enrollment of 134 students
- Full virtual academy using Edmentum platform
- Aligns with state instructional standards
- Combines synchronous and asynchronous learning

Synchronous and Asynchronous Learning

- Scheduled live lessons for core subjects
- Flexible, recorded lessons and resources
- Customizable schedules for assignment completion
